The Physics Department of the University of Massachusetts Amherst seeks an individual to be responsible for the development, maintenance, and setup of classroom demonstrations for physics and astronomy lectures. Applicants must have a B.S. or B.A. in physics and 3 years of relevant experience. Strong organizational abilities, demonstrated hands-on facility with laboratory equipment, confident computer skills, and deep interest in innovative teaching and presentation technologies are essential. The ability to interact effectively with faculty and supervise student assistants will also be required. The successful applicant will be encouraged to develop new lecture demonstrations and to promote outreach to local schools. This is a Grade 14, Step 1 position with a starting salary of \$32,637. A start date of August 15, 2008 is preferred.
